he Black Sea Region is a heterogeneous space. Countries such as Ukraine, Azerbaijan, Romania and Turkey have their own historical and cultural legacy, regime types and economic potential. However, at the same time, they all share one common feature: despite their high potential as a destination for international business operations, international companies often stop short of entering their markets. This is due to the major political risks these countries share - factors related to state capture, disfavouritism, informal practices, institutional ambiguity, authoritarianism and (international) conflict. Major international programs such as the EU-led "Eastern Partnership" and the Chinese-led "One Belt One Road Initiative" stress the region's geopolitical importance and economic potential. However, it is unlikely that these initiatives will make the countries safer business destinations, at least in the mid-term.

The Competence Centre for Black Sea Region Studies offers in-depth knowledge of the above-mentioned constellation. We have developed innovative academic models and approaches to political risk and political risk management by combining insights from both Political Science and International Business Studies. The Competence Centre for Black Sea Region Studies draws on an extensive network, both in the academic world and beyond it, inside and outside the region. In addition, we have a longterm track record of carrying out field research in countries such as Ukraine, Azerbaijan, Georgia and Turkmenistan. At the same time, we are a partner in international research projects. Given this background, we are always ready to extend our academic cooperation by offering excellent teaching, innovative approaches and first-hand empirical insights into the Black Sea Region.
